Program Rules & Information

Practice location will vary between P.B. Ritch, Dobbins Middle, and Hiram High School. Times will vary from 6:00pm – 8:30pm weekly. Teams will practice 2 to 3 times per week.

Games are usually on Saturday and Sunday afternoons; however, there are usually 2 to 3 games played on weeknights. Each team will play approximately **20 -30** games including pre and post season tournaments and Holiday tournaments (Thanksgiving and Christmas).

Practice starts on time. It is the player's responsibility to be ready at the designated time and place. All practices and games are mandatory.

Gym Rules

If your team is practicing at HHS the following expectations are to be followed:

- Players should not enter the gym unless their coach or assistant coach is present
- Practices are closed to reduce traffic flow in HS and from non-HS personnel (this includes siblings of players)
- Bathrooms must be used with care. No paper towels in toilet and no toilet paper on floor
- If weather is bad, please wait in the lobby area – do not enter gym

If your team is participating at other Paulding County Schools, the following expectations are to be followed:

- All practices are closed (this includes siblings of players)
- Players should be dressed and ready prior to practices
- Parents and Players should stay in the designated area that we are allowed to use. Do not wander around building
- Used the designated restrooms allowed. KEEP area clean. Flush all toilets, throw away paper towels
- Throw away all trash (water, papers)
- Sweep floor daily

Obtaining gym time is very difficult, it is very important that coaches, student-athletes, and parents adhere to all gym/school expectations in order to continue to use without disruption. Scheduling for basketball, volleyball, wrestling, and several other activities out of one main facility is tedious at best, therefore changes are inevitable. Our High School, Hiram, makes every effort to allow the Jr. Program access to the facilities and for this privilege we are extremely fortunate and grateful. We would like to thank our stakeholders for adhering to the rules of our program and that of Hiram High School.

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Parent Agreement

1. All fees must be paid in full by the date indicated. If you are unable to meet this date, please contact your team representative immediately to make payment arrangements.
2. Parents are not allowed to speech with Coaches on Game Days, especially prior to a game. Any issues concerning your child should be addressed after practice or with a phone call. Please respect your Coaches. This is a voluntary job.
3. Parents must work concession stand at their assigned time. If you are unable to work at your assigned time, you are responsible for finding a replacement. You must report any changes to your team representative. CONCESSION DUTY IS MANDATORY. Parents must submit a separate \$150.00 refundable check. The check will be refunded at the end of the season if all Concessions are worked. Uniforms will not be issued until we receive the concession stand check.
4. All players must submit a copy of their birth certificate to the team representative. This MUST BE ON FILE FOR EACH PLAYER, before the season begins.
5. All players are guaranteed **PRACTICE TIME**. Playing time during games is solely at the coaches' discretion.
6. Parents must assure that players arrive at games and practices at the designated times.
7. Parents agree to all Programs Guidelines, Gym Guidelines, and Player & Parent Expectations.
